Selection criteria: the Croatian National Bibliography is defined as a list of Croatian publications, printed from 1483, when the first Croatian book was issued. According to the language, national, territorial and subject criteria, bibliography includes works of Croatian authors (Croats by birth and by choice, people who, through their activities in the country or abroad, made a significant contribution to Croatian culture), Croatian publishers (publishers who worked in Croatia or Croatian publishers abroad), publications issued in Croatian language (regardless of the nationality of the author and place of printing) and publications about Croatia, Croats and Croatian cultural and natural heritage.

Includes 3685 names of Croatian authors who wrote in Latin and bibliographic records of their publications issued from the 15th till the middle of the 19th century. The database is searchable by the author and by the title. Entries give locations for Croatian libraries that hold the copies.

The book covers Latin language imprints issued in Yugoslavia or by Yugoslavian authors/editors/translators up to 1848. Three volumes cover three areas: Croatia,

Slovenia and Serbia. Part I is for Croatia. Entries give bibliographic data, locations for European libraries that hold the title and citations to bibliographies in which the works are located. Records and the introduction are only in Latin.

Bibliography of books, magazines and newspapers published in Zadar, arranged chronologically by year of publication. Vol. I is a list of books, Vol. II is a list of periodicals. The over 1800 entries provide a full bibliographic citation plus a physical description and an abbreviation which indicates where the item is held.
