**Period covered**: 1473 – to data

**Responsible institution:** the National Széchényi Library; the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (inform@szk.hu)

**Selection criteria**: 1) works published within the borders of Hungary at a given time, in any language; 2) works published outside the borders of Hungary at a given time, written in the Hungarian language; 3) works written by Hungarian authors, published in any country and in any language; 4) works with a Hungarian aspect

Electronic database was created on the basis of the printed national bibliographic sources:

This bibliography served as the actual basis for the Hungarian National Bibliography. It chronologically lists books published in Hungarian and about Hungary during 1473-1711. Vol. I contains nearly 1800 titles published in Hungarian from 1531 to 1711. Vol. II compiles nearly 2500 titles published between 1473-1711 in Hungary in foreign languages. The two parts of vol. III include over 4800 titles by Hungarian authors, published abroad in 1480-1670 and 1671-1711, respectively.

This bibliography is prepared by the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. The aim of the RMNy is to create detailed descriptions of all publications printed during 1473-1800 in Hungarian language in Hungary (in the borders of the Kingdom of Hungary with the exclusion of Croatia and Slavonia) and abroad and works issued in Hungary in foreign languages. Entries are arranged chronologically. The first four volumes of the RMNY (up to 1670) contain 3697 items. Contains a lot of titles from RMK, but the records are more detailed.
