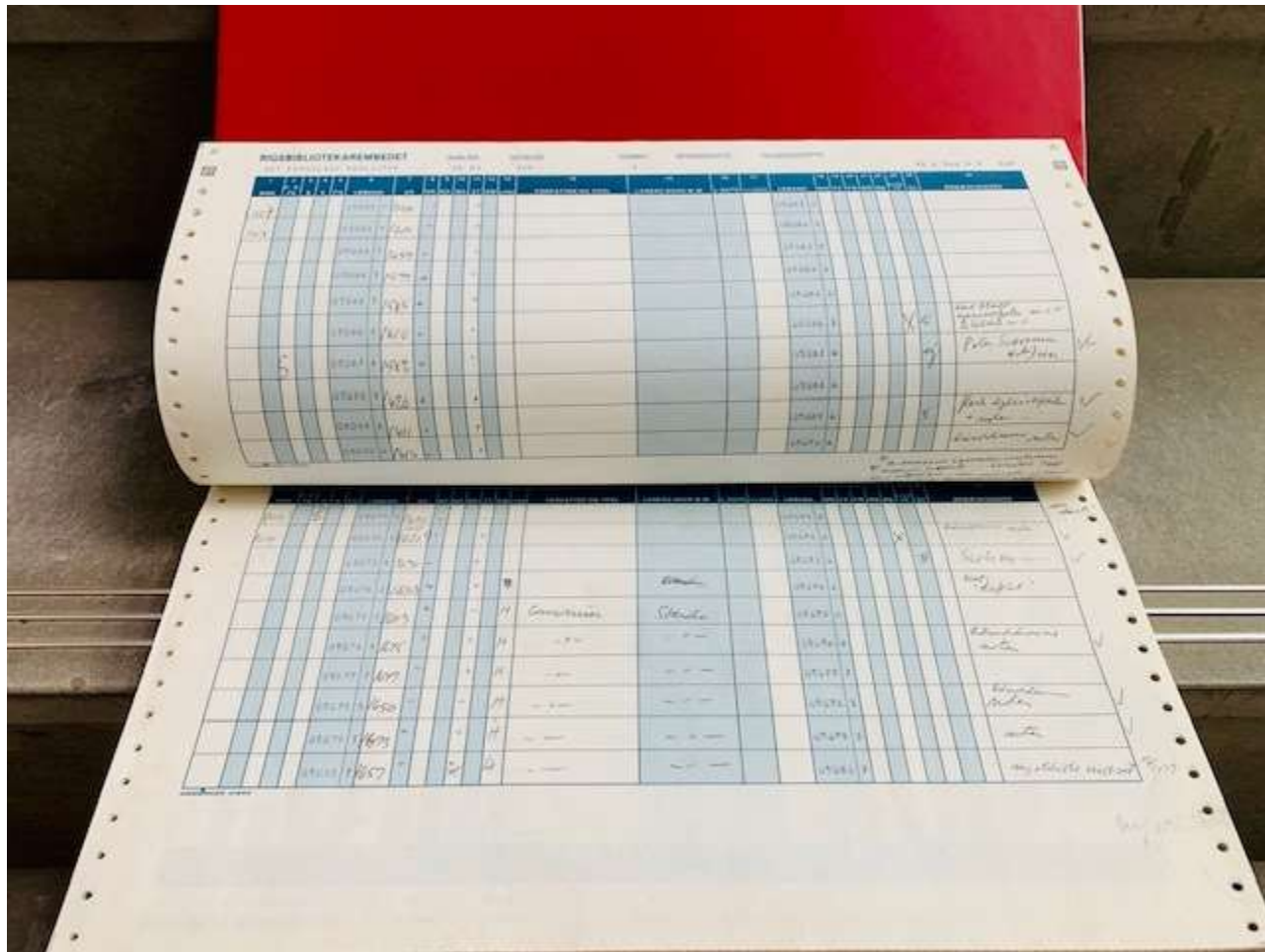

Background

- 1970s theft of books
- 1979-99: a complete revision of UAÆS books from 1531-1949
- Pre-printed protocols for revision
- Materials were given a barcode
- During revision the missing volumes were recorded, the physical condition of the books', book historical characteristics such as binding, provenance, etc. and security levels
- Result: a list of missing books for replacement + lots of book history data
- In 1999, the red lists were put aside and forgotten



The red lists

- 2010: Staff at Reading Room West began updating the catalogue posts with these data without having to request the material
- Superexlibris, exlibris, owner's marks etc.
- Notes on medieval fragments
- Binding information
- General notes
- ? marked an unknown provenance, the material was requested, photographed and saved for later clarification

- Additional provenance information is registered for a preparation project for remote storage stacks.



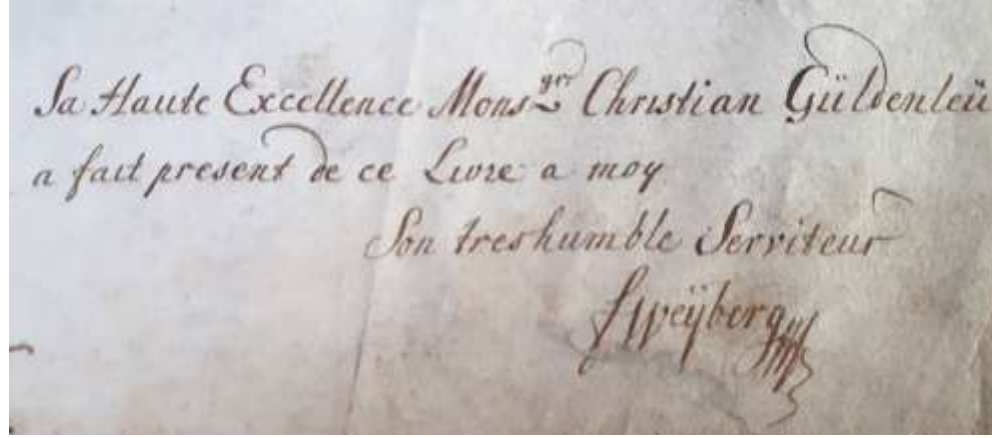

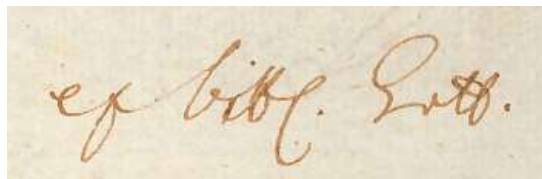
- **Crowned, lying lion with a ball under his paw**
- Adam Pérelle: *Veües des belles maisons de France ; Veües de Rome et des environ*, ca. 1680-90?



- Signed **Frederik Weyberg** (d. 1720), diplomat. *Sa Haute Excellence Monsgr Christian Güldenleü a fait present de ce Livre à moy Son tres humble Serviteur F. Weyberg*

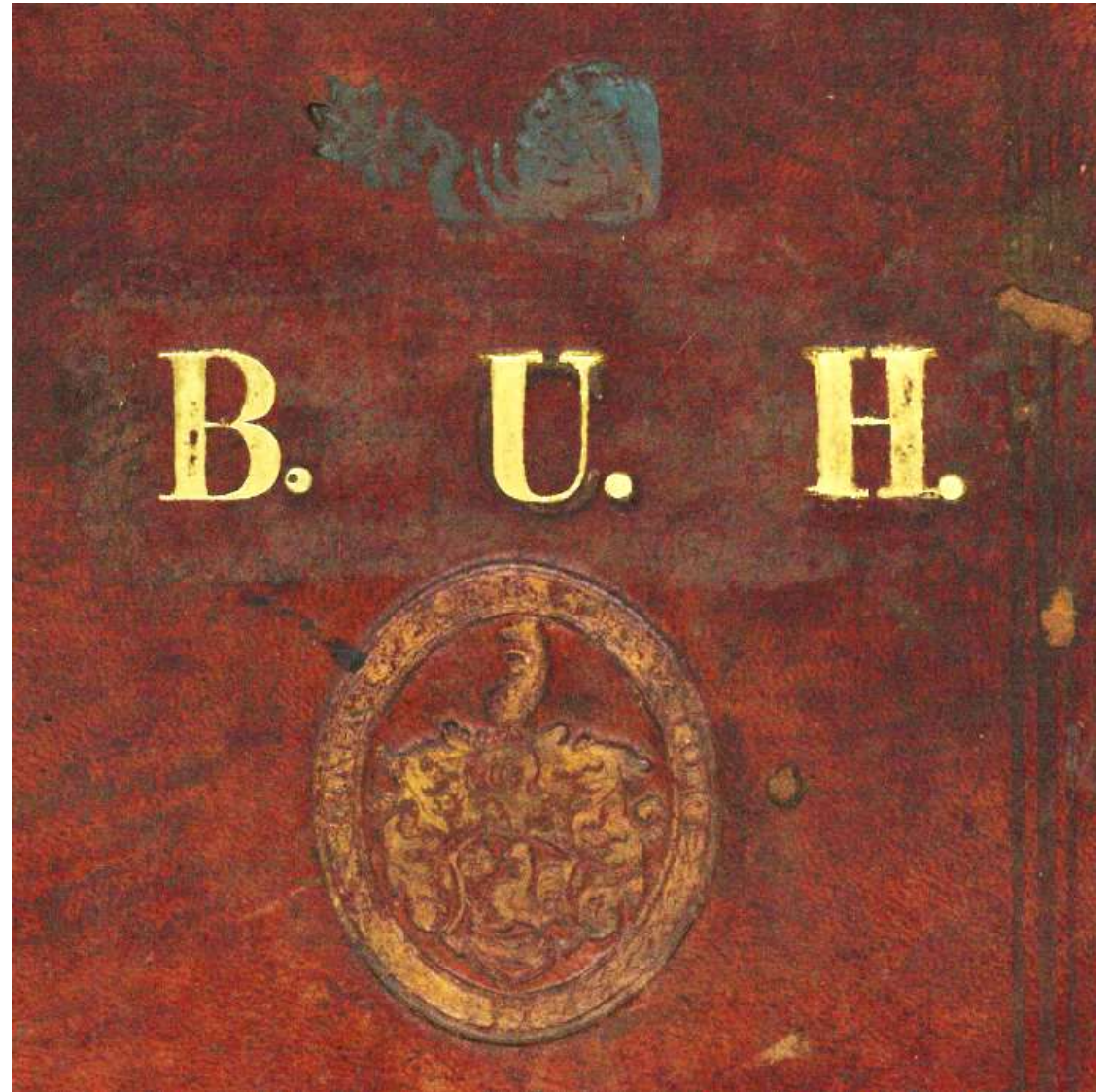
Augustenborg

- **Charlotte Marie**, married Glücksborg, 1697-1760, C M, crown and lion
- Brother Christian August (1696-1754) used the same design with the letters C A
- Louis de Mally: *L'Eloge de la chasse, avec plusieurs aventures surprenantes & agreables qui y sont arrivées : Présenté au Roy, Paris, 1723*
- **Frederik Christian**, duke of Augustenborg (1765-1814)
- Paul Decker: *Fürstlicher Baumeister*, Augsburg, 1711-1716



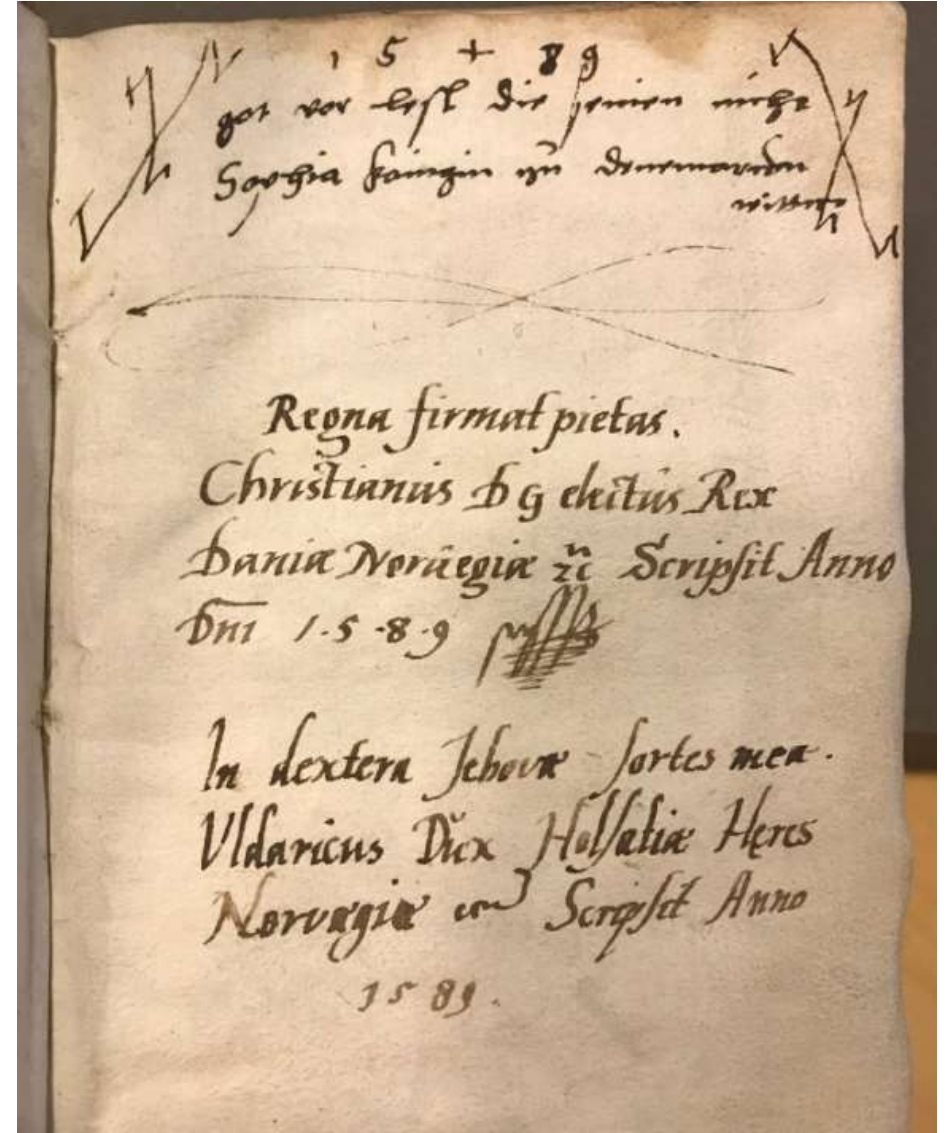
Luxdorph, B.U.H., Rosenhane

- **Bolle Luxdorph** (1716-1788)
- **B.U.H.** (Bibliotheca Universitatis Hafniensis)
- **Rosenhane**: coat of arms with the motto: Matvre & consvlto, Swedish family, Johan Göransson Rosenhane (d. 1624)
- Pastedown; Johan Månsson Rehn
- Title page: J. Lonneman m.fl.
- *Uplandz Laghen, sum af Byrger Magnusa son Swea ok Giötha Kununga*, Stockholm, 1607, UB1 Gl. Samling



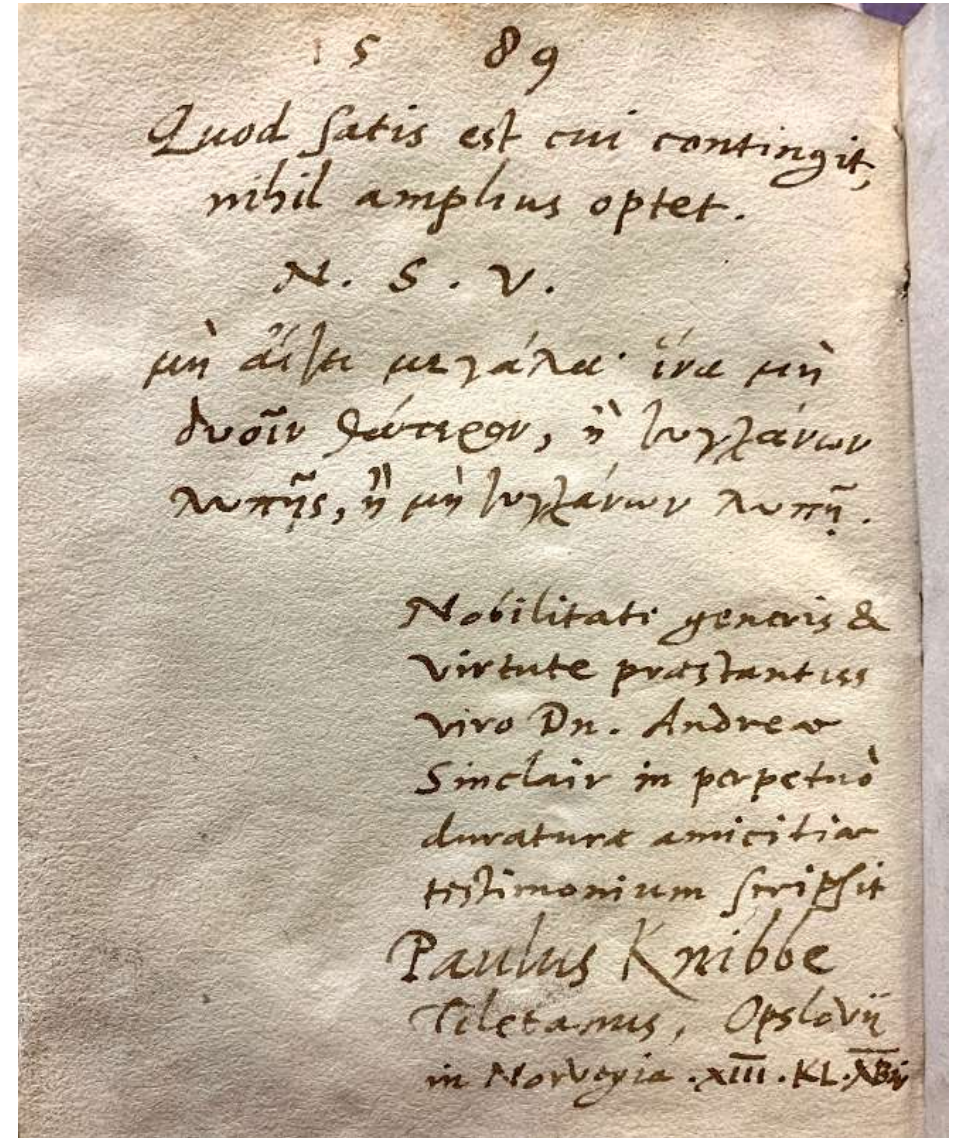
Andrew Sinclair (1555-1625)

- The Scottish nobleman **Sinclair** came to Denmark in connection with the wedding between Princess Anne and James VI of Scotland. He used the book as an album amicorum to collect greetings.
- **Sophie** (1557-1631): 1589 / got fur lest die seinen nicht. Sophia Konigin zu Denemarcken / witwe
- **Christian IV** (1577-1648) Regna firmat pietas D.G. electus Rex
- **Ulrik** (1578-1624): In dextera Jehovæ fortes meæ Uldaricus Dux Holsatiæ Heres Norvegiæ
- **Other greetings from:** Arild Huitfeldt, Corftiz Viffert, Sten Brahe, Axel og Karen Gyldenstjerne, Peder Munk, Christoffer Valkendorf, Niels Kaas, Jørgens Rosenkrantz, Steen Bille, Eric Lange, Tycho Brahe (Uraniburgi at Hven) etc.
- *Plutarque 1584, d.e. Les vies des hommes illvstres, grecs et romains, comparees l'vne avec l'autre par Plutarque de Chæronée.* Paris, 1584



Andrew Sinclair (1555-1625)

- **Paulus Knibbe** (Flemish born diplomat): escorted Princess Anne from Denmark to Scotland in 1589, the ship went off course and ended up in Norway. Knibbe signed the book in Opslovii (19 November 1589), the wedding took place on 23 November
- **Christian Sinclair** (d. 1645, son) passed the book on in 1632: *J'ay donné ce liure a Braconiere [...], Sinclairsholm*
- **Eiler Ulfeldt**
- **Laurids Ulfeldt** (1605-59): signature on title page with the year 1634. With his book collection, Plutarque came via auction to the Royal Library (1662)

- Princess Charlotte Amalie's (1706-1782) library
- Stamped: **DUPL: BIBL: REG:** (Duplicata Bibliotheca Regia), handwritten 1786. Sold as a doublet at an auction
- **Suhm:** bought by P.F. Suhm (1728-1798) →
- **RDL:** bought it back at an auction of Suhm's books in 1796
- Johann Andreas Cramer: *Areopagus. Predigt bey Gelegenheit des Geburtstages des Königes und der Einweihung des Friedrichshospitales*, 1757
