The need to include images in the description of early-printed books cannot be denied. Printer's devices combine pictures, texts (mottoes) and printer-related information in very elaborate and variable ways, which ask for specific bibliographical tools. Moreover, a certain part of them lose its original context and can be found today in single-leaf collections, which need specific kinds of indexing for their part. There are a lot of current initiatives to establish models of description in different databases. We think it important to make a survey of current research activities and discuss possible methods of description in order to link those initiatives and get confirmed standards for recording printers' devices in future projects.
