Every morning a UNED pick-up service will be available for delegates to get from the hotel to the Conference venue.

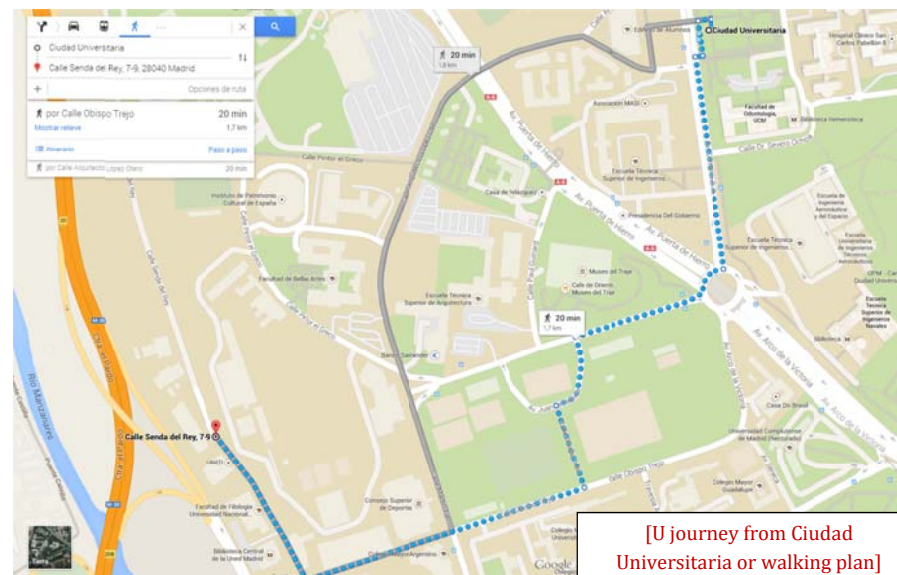
Delegates can also take a taxi or public transportation. The Conference venue is located at **Paseo de la Senda del Rey, 11 (28040), Madrid**.

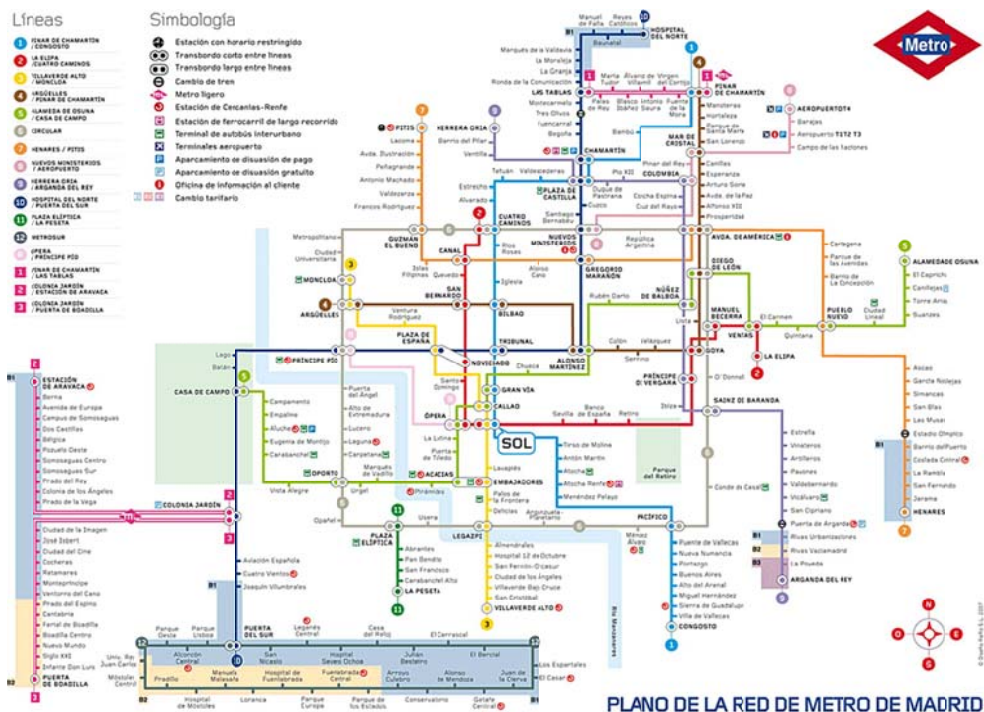
